Pokerverse is an innovative and rewarding gaming platform, where entertainment combines with the chance to earn valuable cryptocurrencies and NFTs. Through our gaming ecosystem, which includes free-to-earn, tournaments, and Sit&Gos across the metaverse, players are rewarded for their skill and effort. Furthermore, it is possible to purchase a table and become a Dealer, hosting and earning from players who use the table.

POKERVERSE VISION

Goals

The Pokerverse team aims to use Texas Hold'em to create an innovative game that solves the GameFi trilemma.

Most Web 3.0 games sacrifice profitability by requiring high entry fees to fund rewards or accessibility, making it difficult for non-blockchain-savvy users to manage the crypto wallet. Other games abandon gameplay to chase crypto market speculation, migrating Web2.0 games into Web3.0 without considering the suitability of the token model and game economics.

Because of these problems, current web3 games often fail to solve the GameFi trilemma.

The GameFi trilemma

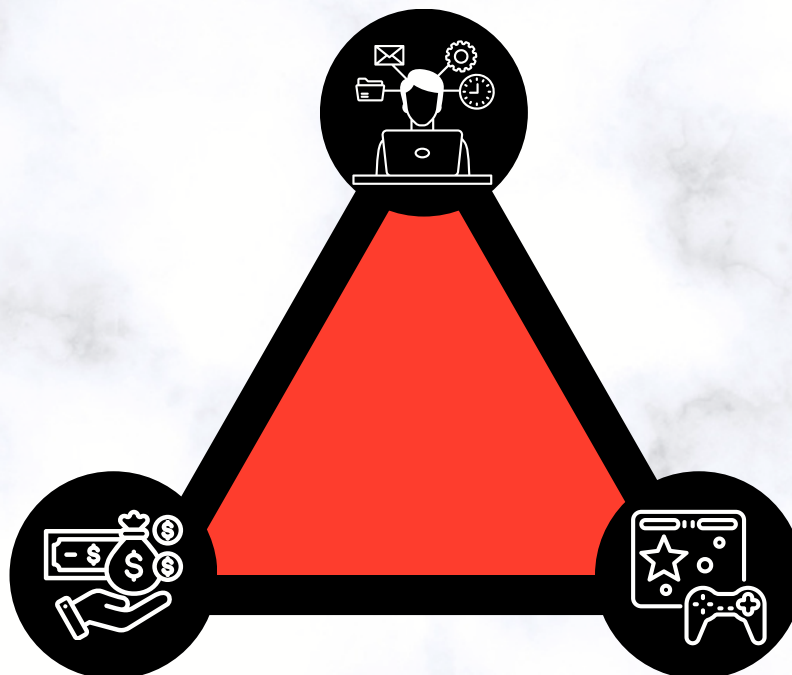
The GameFi trilemma is made up of three components: playability, profitability and accessibility. The problem arises from the fact that only two components can be possible at a time.

Playability: Players should enjoy playing the game.

Profitability: Players must be able to earn money by playing the game.

Accessibility: The game must be accessible to everyone.

Equity

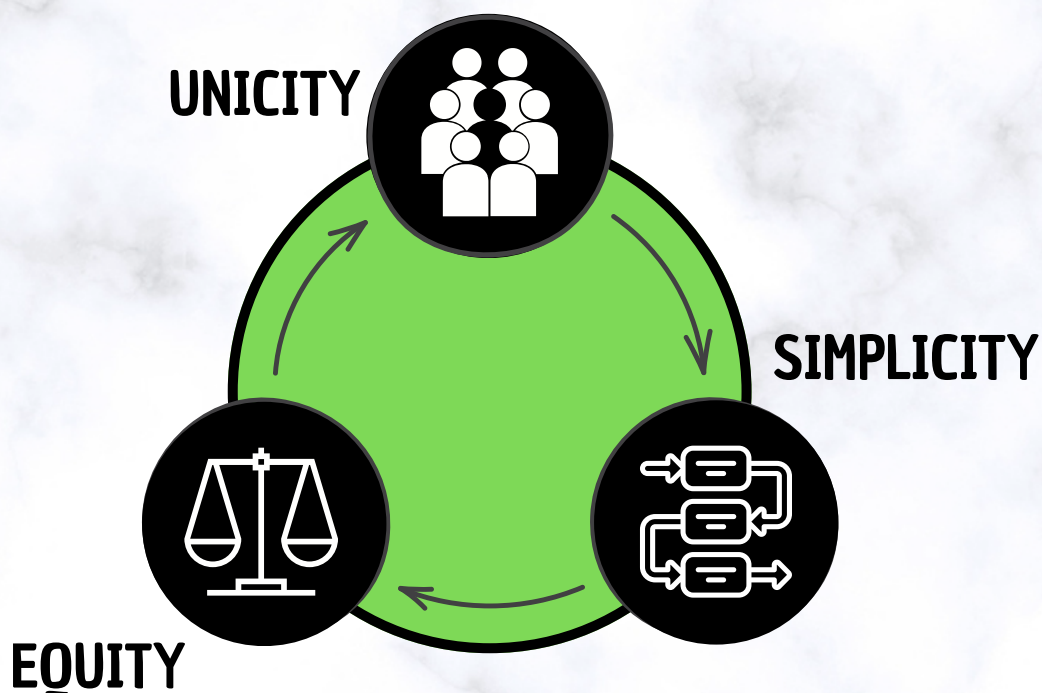
Our game has a healthy economy that allows everyone to earn fairly.

HOW TO START

Log in

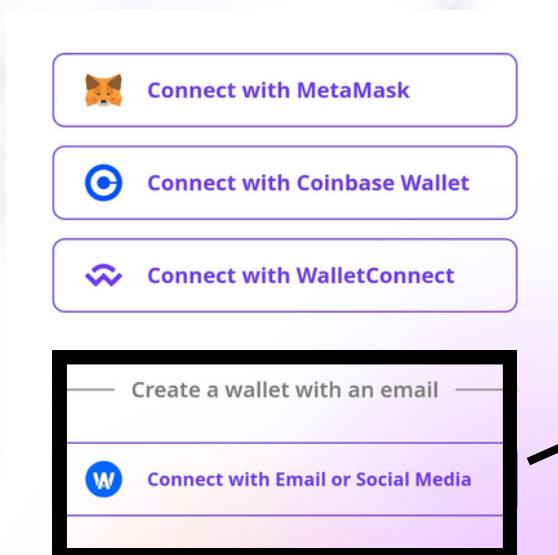
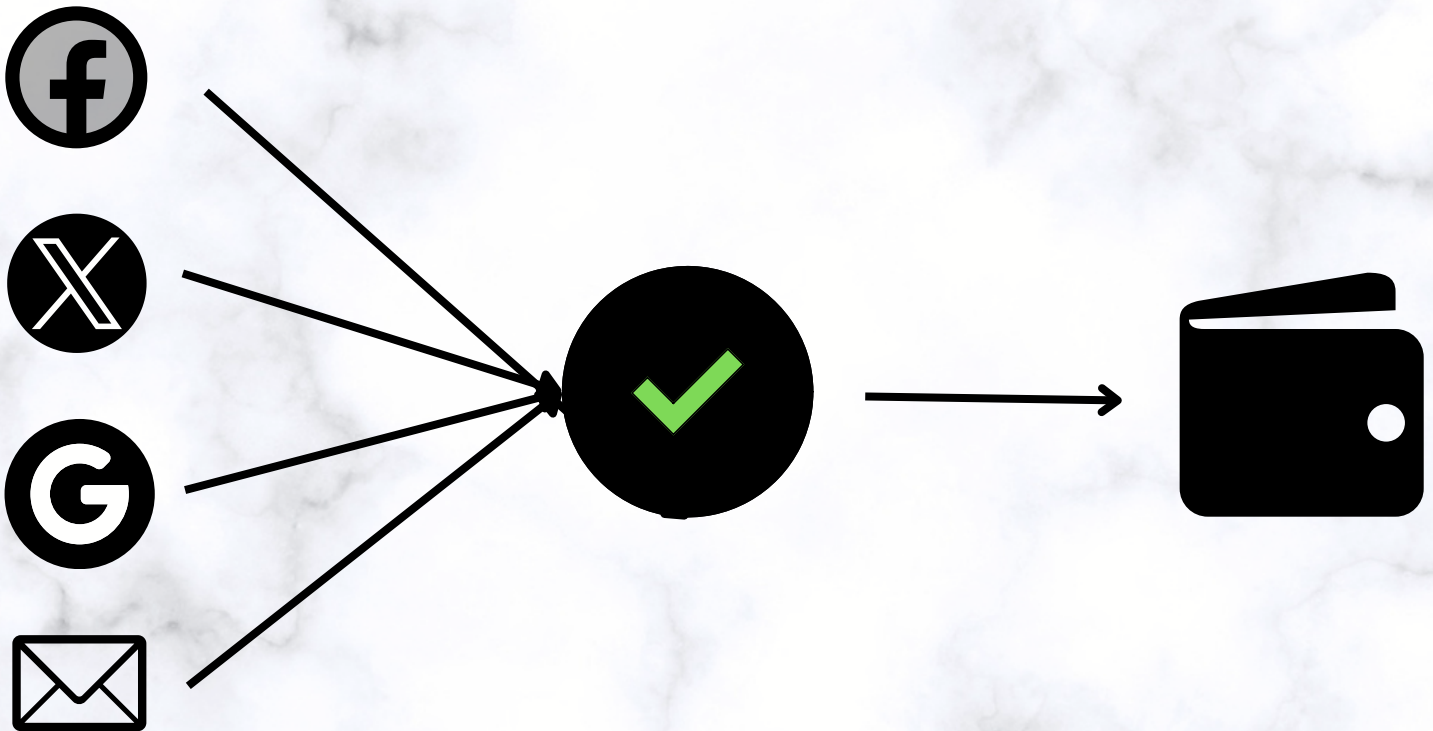
To launch the game, you need to follow these simple steps:

1. Log in to www.Pokerverse.poker
2. Click the "Connect" button
3. Choose to connect using an EVM wallet like Metamask or widget
4. Enter a nickname and choose a profile picture

Widget Wallet

When we talk about widgets in programming, we are referring to elements of the graphical user interface that allow you to interact with applications.

Therefore, when we talk about wallet widgets we are referring to small applications that allow access in a simpler way.

PUKE Token

PUKE is an ERC-20 token built on the Ethereum blockchain. It is the native currency of Pokerverse.

The PUKE token is used to access services or features within the Pokerverse ecosystem.

In the case of PUKE, it can be used to buy or mine NFTs.

They can be used to play against other players in Sit&Goverse, Tournaments and Events.

Or staked to increase the liquidity of the token.

Burning

To keep the PUKE Token economy stable and sustainable, tokens spent within the Sit&Goverse, Marketplace and Mint will be subject to Burning.

Tokens spent in Sit&Goverse will have a burning rate of 2%.

Tokens spent buying and selling NFTs between players in the Marketplace will have a burning rate of 2%.

Tokens spent to mine Pass will have a Burning rate of 2%.



TABLE

The table is a piece of digital real estate in the Pokerverse's Sit&Goverse.

Each table is a unique ERC-721 NFT on the Ethereum blockchain.

A total of 5000 Tables are available.

You can become a DEALER by owning a table and earning from the games played on your table, setting the Buy-In, activating/deactivating the table.

You can buy or sell the table in the Marketplace.

Dealer setting

The Dealer can set the Buy-In, activate/deactivate the table, redeem the earnings and must follow these simple steps:

1 Click on "menu"

2 Click on "Dealer Login"

3 Click "Deposit Table"

4 Choose one of the 8 Buy-In options

1 PUKE	50 PUKE
5 PUKE	100 PUKE
10 PUKE	200 PUKE
20 PUKE	500 PUKE

To deactivate, do the same steps above and click "Deactivate Table"

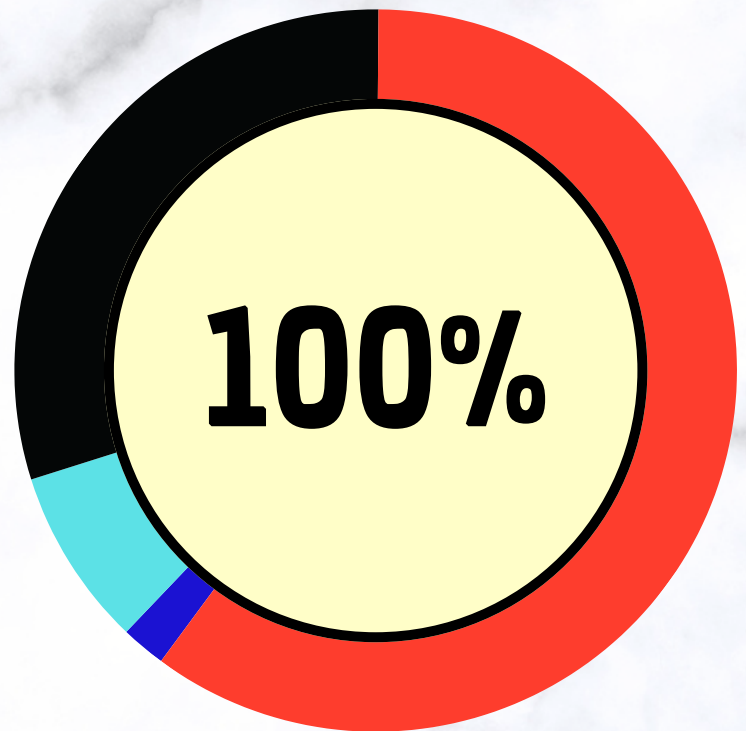
To withdraw earnings, do the same steps above and click "Withdraw Gain"

note: a deactivated table cannot host players and does not generate income.

Distribution of table prizes

Example: A game with 9 players has just ended on the table with a Buy-In of 10 PUKE per person.

- $9 \times 10 = 90$ TOTAL
- $90 \times 0,02 = 1,8$ BURN
- $90 \times 0,08 = 7,2$ DEALER
- $90 \times 0,60 = 54$ FIRST
- $90 \times 0,30 = 27$ SECOND

CHIPS

Chips are a versatile resource that is used in two ways: as a currency to participate in "Free to Play" and as a tool to improve "Passes".

To start, each player receives 10,000 Chips as a daily bonus.

However, you can accumulate Chips in other ways, including:

By playing in the "Free to Play" and winning Chips from other players.

By purchasing Chips on the Marketplace.

Watching advertisements.

Furthermore, when you accumulate Chips in significant quantities, you can convert them into ERC-1155 NFTs in the Mint section.

Mint NFT Here's how the conversion to NFT works:

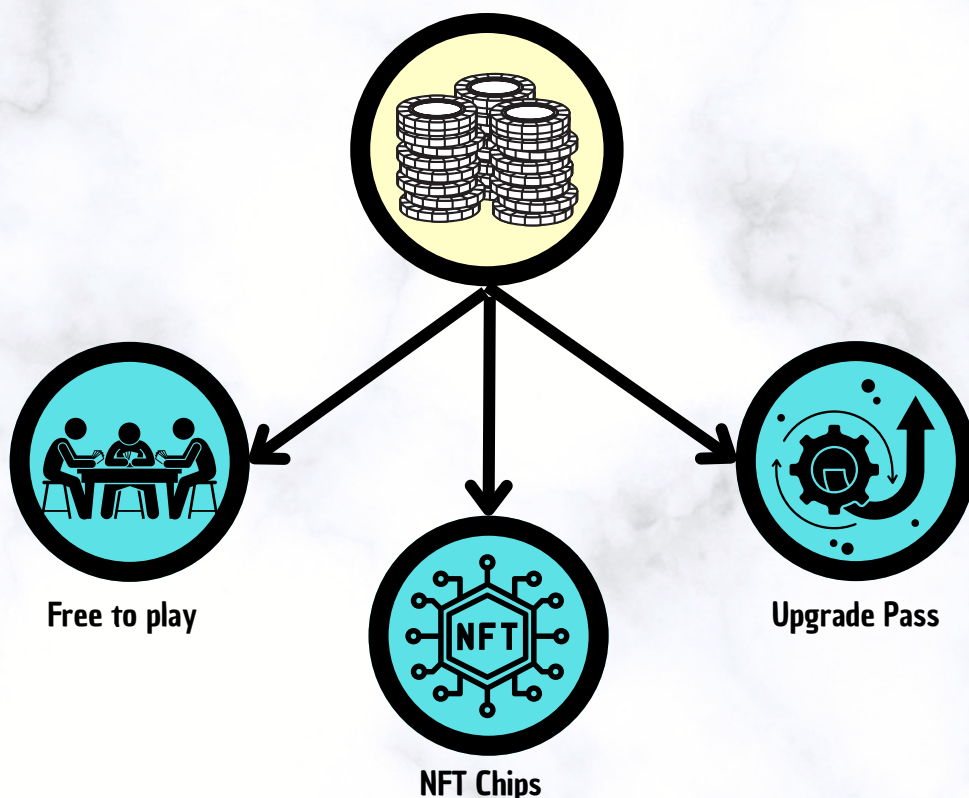
1.400.000 Chips = 1.000.000 NFT Chips

7.000.000 Chips = 5.000.000 NFT Chips

14.000.000 Chips = 10.000.000 NFT Chips

ADS

Every time you watch an advertisement, you receive 5,000 Chips.



PASS

The Pass are ERC-1155 NFTs on the Ethereum blockchain. There are 53 in total, each with its own rarity.

By attaching them to the appropriate album, you can access tournaments and stake to earn PUKE tokens.

To increase staking strength, it is possible to increase Pass levels using CHIPS accumulated in free to play or purchased in the Marketplace, up to a maximum of 10 levels.

Pass Rarity Drop.

Passes are classified by rarity and have the following drop probabilities:

Access to Tournaments.

To participate in the daily tournament, you must have 1 Pass in the album.

To participate in the daily and weekly tournament, you need to have 3 Pass in the album.

To participate in the daily, weekly and bi-weekly tournaments, you need to have 5 Pass in the album.

Stake.

The Pass are staked in the following way: $\text{NFT} = \text{Stable} \times \text{APR} = \text{Token}$.
If the album is completed, all Passes will receive an additional 2X boost in staking

SIT&GOVERSE

Sit&Goverse is an Earth-like spherical world made up of 5000 NFT tables. The game in the metaverse is offered in Sit&Go mode. Players can bet and win other players' tokens, interact and discover this world.

How to play

1. Hold PUKE tokens.
2. Log in to Sit&Goverse.
3. Choose the table manually or use the quick address for the first available table.
4. The Buy-In and a 30-minute countdown are projected above each table.
5. The tables can accommodate 5 to 9 players.
6. The game starts when the table reaches at least 5 players within the countdown.
7. If the table does not reach the minimum number of 5 players within 30 minutes, the game is canceled and players removed from the table without penalty.
8. If the table reaches the maximum of 9 participants before the end of the countdown, the game starts within 10 seconds.
9. Each player receives 2000 starting chips.
10. The initial Small/Big Blind is 100/200 Chips.
11. The doubling of the Small/Big Blind occurs every 4.30 minutes from the start of the game.
12. The player has 30 seconds to perform an action. Otherwise, his hand will be considered "Check" or "Pass".

Award

The prizes will be awarded to the first and second place in this order: 60% of the prize money to the first place, 30% of the prize money to the second place and 10% divided between Dealer and Burn.

FREE TO PLAY

The objective is to accumulate Chips.
The game in the Free version of Pokerverse takes place in Cash Game mode.
It is the ideal place for new players who want to start earning for free and become familiar with the game.

How to play

Redeem the 10,000 Free Daily Chips.
The player is randomly assigned to an available table.
The game starts with a minimum of 2 players on the table.
The Small/Big Blind is 100/200 Chips.
Players have 30 seconds to carry out an action. If they do not do so, their hand will be considered "Check" or "Pass".
The game end when the player has no more Chips to bet.

Chips

Chips are the game resource in Free to play.
By logging into Free to Play daily, you receive an entry bonus of 10,000 chips to start playing.
It is also possible to accumulate chips by viewing the advertising campaigns or purchasing in the Marketplace.

TOURNAMENT

The Pokerverse tournament is divided into 3 groups and is played in Cash Game mode. This is "No Lost Game", which means that participants can play by simply staking the Token or Pass in the album. The objective of the tournaments is to reach the Top50.

The Tournaments

Daily: takes place every two days.

Weekly: takes place weekly.

Biweekly: takes place every two weeks.

Requirements for participation, Token

To participate in the Daily, you must stake \$50 worth of tokens. To participate in the Daily and Weekly, you must stake \$35 worth of tokens for three months.

To participate in the Daily, Weekly, and Biweekly, you must stake \$20 worth of tokens for one year.

Requirements for participation, Pass

To participate in the Daily, you must have 1 Pass in your album.

To participate in the Daily and Weekly, you must have 3 Pass in your album.

To participate in the Daily, Weekly and Biweekly, you must have 5 Pass in your album.

How to play

The player is randomly assigned to an available table.

The game starts with a minimum of 2 players on the table.

The player has 500 hands and 10,000 chips at his disposal.

The Small/Big Blind is 100/200 Chips.

The player has 30 seconds to perform an action. If he does not, his hand will be considered "Check" or "Pass".

The objective is to accumulate as many Chips as possible during the tournament and reach the Top50.

The game ends when the player runs out of chips, when he runs out of 500 available hands or when the tournament comes to an end.

Tournament prize distribution

The prizes of the 3 tournaments are awarded as follows:

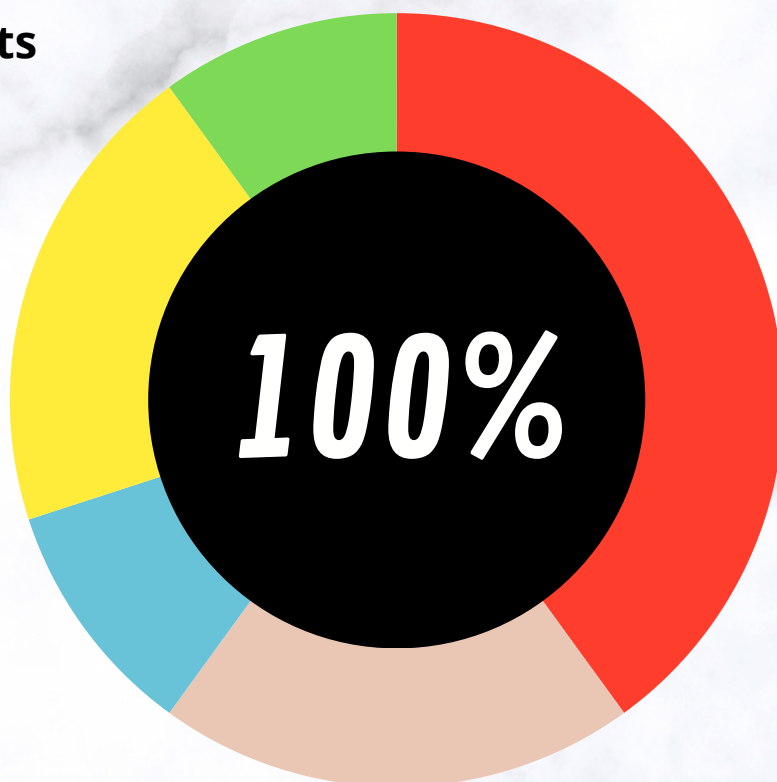
First place: 40% of the prize money.

Second place: 20% of the prize money.

Third place: 10% of the prize money.

From the fourth to the tenth:
10% of the prize pool divided into 7 parts.

From the eleventh to the fiftieth:
20% of the prize pool divided into 40 parts.



Note: Winners have 48 hours to collect the prizes, beyond 48 hours, the prizes will be burned

EVENT

POKERVERSE Events are special tournaments organized by the team during Bear Markets or on the occasion of big dates such as Christmas, Chinese New Year or Bitcoin Halving. The tournament is played in Cash Game mode and participation is upon completion of the White List or purchased with the token.

How to play

player is randomly assigned to an available table.

The game starts with a minimum of 2 players on the table.

The player has 500 hands and 10,000 chips at his disposal.

The Small/Big Blind is 100/200 Chips.

The player has 30 seconds to perform an action. If he does not, his hand will be considered "Check" or "Pass".

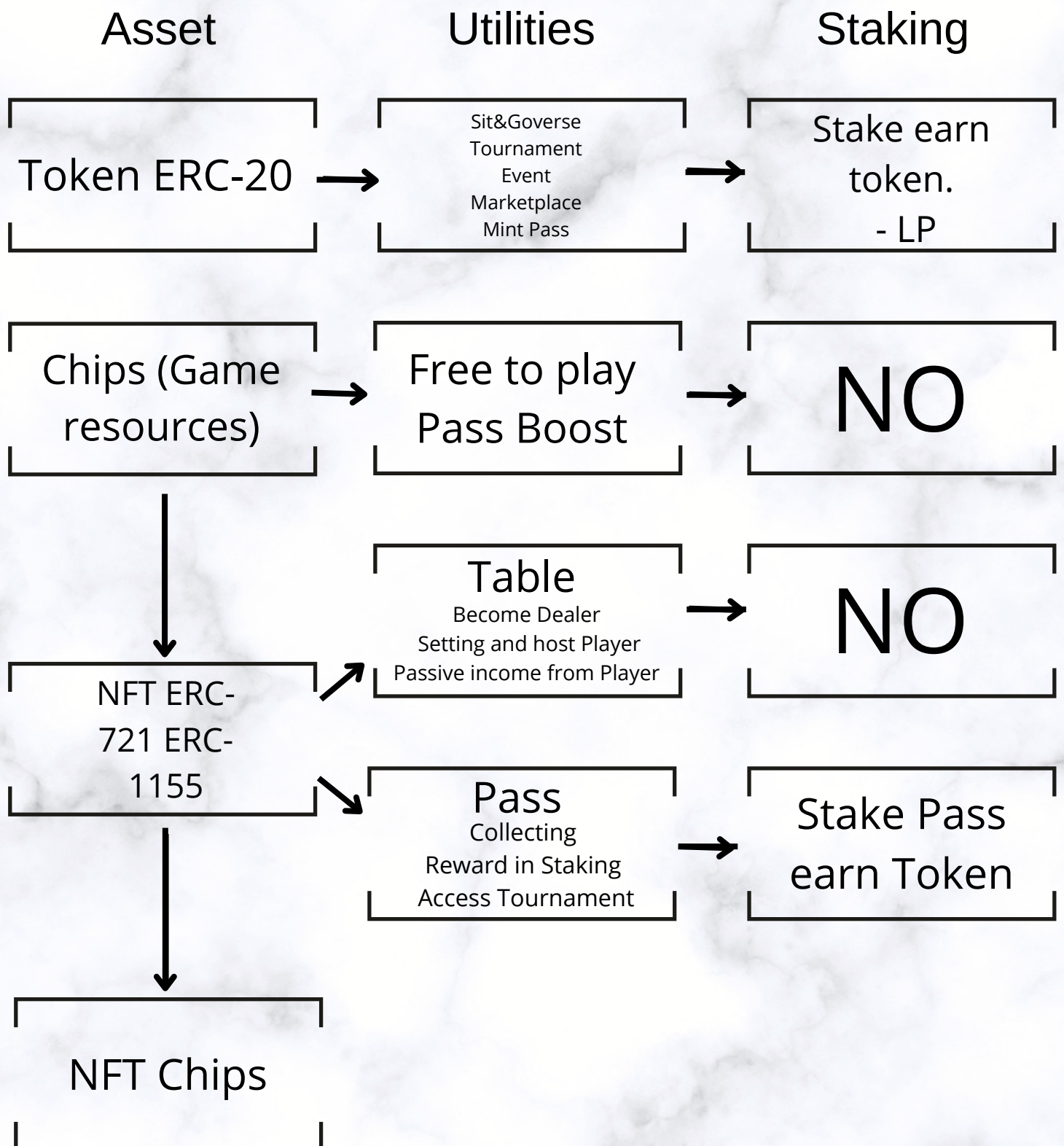
The objective is to accumulate as many Chips as possible during the tournament and reach the Top50.

Award

Prizes for Pokerverse Events vary and will be communicated 30 days in advance through social channels and ADS campaigns.

MARKETPLACE

The Pokerverse Marketplace uses the PUKE token as its reference currency. However, NFTs trade at a fixed value in USDT, with a 2% fee that goes to Burning.

This way, the price of NFTs remains constant, regardless of the buyer or seller, making the Marketplace transparent and predictable.

Example:

NFT on sale at 10 USDT value and PUKE Token value at \$0.50 = 20 PUKE to buy NFT.

How to buy.

To purchase, follow these simple steps:

1. Have the PUKE token.
2. Access the Marketplace.
3. Choose the desired NFT.
4. Click on "Buy".

How to Sell

To sell, follow these simple steps:

1. Access the Marketplace.
2. Click on "Sell".
3. Choose the desired NFT.
4. Click on "List".

MINT

Mint Pass.

To "mint" a Pass, follow these simple steps:

Hold PUKE tokens. Access the Mint section.

Click on "Pass mint".

Click on "Mint".

Mint Chips.

To "mint" Chips, follow these simple steps:

Have at least 1,400,000 Chips.

Access the Mint section.

"Chip like".

Enter the desired quantity. Click on "Mint".

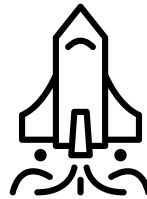

FAQ

Which random number generator do you use for the game?

We have been using one of the best random generators on the market since 1998: RANDOM.ORG Random.org uses a method called "noise-based random number generator" to generate its random numbers. This method is based on the principle that the physical world is inherently random, and collects random data from the real world, such as atmospheric noise, Internet traffic, and computer mouse movements. This data is then used to generate random numbers.

The Tables are NFT ERC-721 and the Pass and Chips ERC-1155, what is the difference?

The key difference between an ERC-721 token and an ERC-1155 token is fungibility. ERC-721 tokens are non-fungible, meaning they are unique. Each ERC-721 token has its own unique identifier and cannot be exchanged for another ERC-721 token. ERC-1155 tokens, however, can be both fungible and non-fungible. ERC-1155 tokens can be grouped into series, with each series being either fungible or non-fungible.

In other words, an ERC-721 token is like a work of art: it is unique and cannot be replaced. An ERC-1155 token is like a set of playing cards: some cards are the same and can be exchanged with each other, while others are unique and cannot be replaced.

Is it possible to earn PUKE tokens starting from scratch?

Yes, it is possible to earn from scratch. To do this, just play Free to Gain and accumulate Chips. These Chips, once minted into NFTs, can be sold in the Marketplace.

Why Wallet?

A wallet is required to hold PUKE tokens, the Pokerverse game currency. Thanks to PUKE tokens, you can buy NFTs, participate in tournaments and sit & gos, and so on.

Additionally, the wallet is required to claim any rewards you have earned or won, for example through Play-To-Earn. The rewards will be sent and stored in this wallet.

Finally, the wallet can be used to store NFTs you own, such as avatars and tables.
